## Descrição

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Corpo comprimido, coberto com pequenas escamas aderentes; focinho longo, tubular com a boca na sua extremidade; cor rosa avermelhado na parte dorsal e ventre prateado; pode atingir cerca de 15 cm de comprimento.

## Distribuição geográfica

Oceanos Atlântico, Índico e Pacífico, também ocorre no Mediterrâneo.

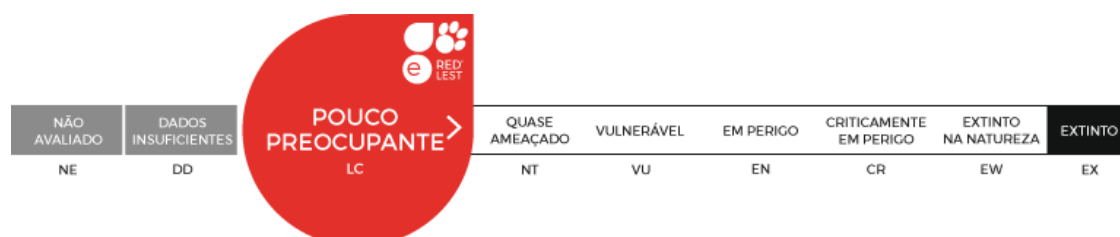
## Habitat e ecologia

Espécie bentopelágica, subtropical, que se encontra principalmente no fundo do mar a profundidades entre 50-350 m e, por vezes, a meio da coluna de água nas porções inferiores da plataforma continental sobre substrato arenoso. É uma espécie gregária, formando cardumes.

## Características identificativas

- O corpo muito comprimido lateralmente;
- O focinho é muito longo e tubular com a boca terminal pequena;
- Possui duas barbatanas dorsais recuadas, praticamente opostas à barbatana anal;
- A primeira barbatana dorsal tem dois espinhos, sendo o 2º muito mais desenvolvido e aguçado, com o bordo posterior serrilhado;
- Os adultos são vermelhos ou rosados com uma tonalidade mais uniforme.
